Special presentation to be held Friday for area residents who hope to work on highway construction projects

Area residents who are interested in working on highway construction crews will want to stop by The Work Station, located at 70 North Plains Road in The Plains, on Friday, July 31.

Beginning at 8:30 a.m. on Friday, David Finley, also known as "The Ohio Highway Guy," will be in the parking lot in his Career Mobile to talk to area residents about apprenticeship programs on highway construction crews. The apprenticeships can lead to full-time work in areas such as heavy equipment operation and general construction labor.

The apprenticeship program is sponsored by the two unions representing most of the highway construction workers in the state.
