Step Up To Quality is Ohio's voluntary quality rating system for ODJFS licensed child care programs. *Step Up To Quality* recognizes early care and education programs that exceed quality benchmarks over and above Ohio's licensing standards in the areas of ratio/group size, staff education/qualifications, specialized training, administrative practices and early learning. Step Up To Quality Programs are only eligible for a Star Rating if they have not had any serious risk licensing non-compliances within the past 12 months. If this program were to have a serious risk non-compliance, their rating would be either suspended or removed based on the non-compliance.

Star Rating Guide: any center with one, two or three stars exceeds quality benchmarks in several areas

- ★ Step One: The first rating once a center has met minimum *Step Up To Quality* standards
- ★★ Step Two: The second rating once a center has met the second tier of *Step Up To Quality* standards.
- ★★★ Step Three: The highest rating in the *Step Up To Quality* program
