The Work Station is hoping to hear from local employers who may have job openings for teenagers and young adults this summer.

In past summers, Athens County Job and Family Services has been able to offer summer employment programs for teens, and the programs proved to be very popular. The agency, however, has lost funding for many of these programs this year and enrollment is limited.

Any local businesses or agencies that may have summer job openings for teens are encouraged to contact The Work Station so that staff members can put the employers in touch with teenagers who are looking for work. The Work Station works with employers throughout the year to help them find qualified employees, and local businesses are always encouraged to contact The Work Station if they need any assistance with hiring. The Work Station can also help local employers by entering their information on state websites that match employers with individuals who lost their jobs due to layoffs, posting job openings on the office Jobs Board, taking applications, posting job openings on The Work Station website, faxing resumes and screening applicants.

The Work Station helps people of all ages find jobs all throughout the year. Located at 70 North Plains Road in The Plains, the office provides numerous free services for all area residents, including the Jobs Board, a computer lab that is open to the public, programs to help people prepare for interviews, a clothing bank where area residents can find outfits to wear to job interviews, an adult education program, job training services and programs for veterans, seniors and individuals with disabilities.
